### **PRELIMINARY STATISTICS FOR GENERAL REGISTRATION OF VOTERS: 03 JUNE – 01 AUGUST 2024**

---

The Commission is pleased to announce the successful conclusion of the 4th General Registration of Voters (GRV) on 01 August 2024. During the *last four days* of the registration period, from the 29 July - 01 August 2024, a total of **152,472** eligible voters were registered. This figure represents an average of **38,002** registered voters per day during the week of **29 July – 01 August 2024**, which is the highest turnout recorded to date compared to the overall turnout recorded weekly since the commencement of GRV.

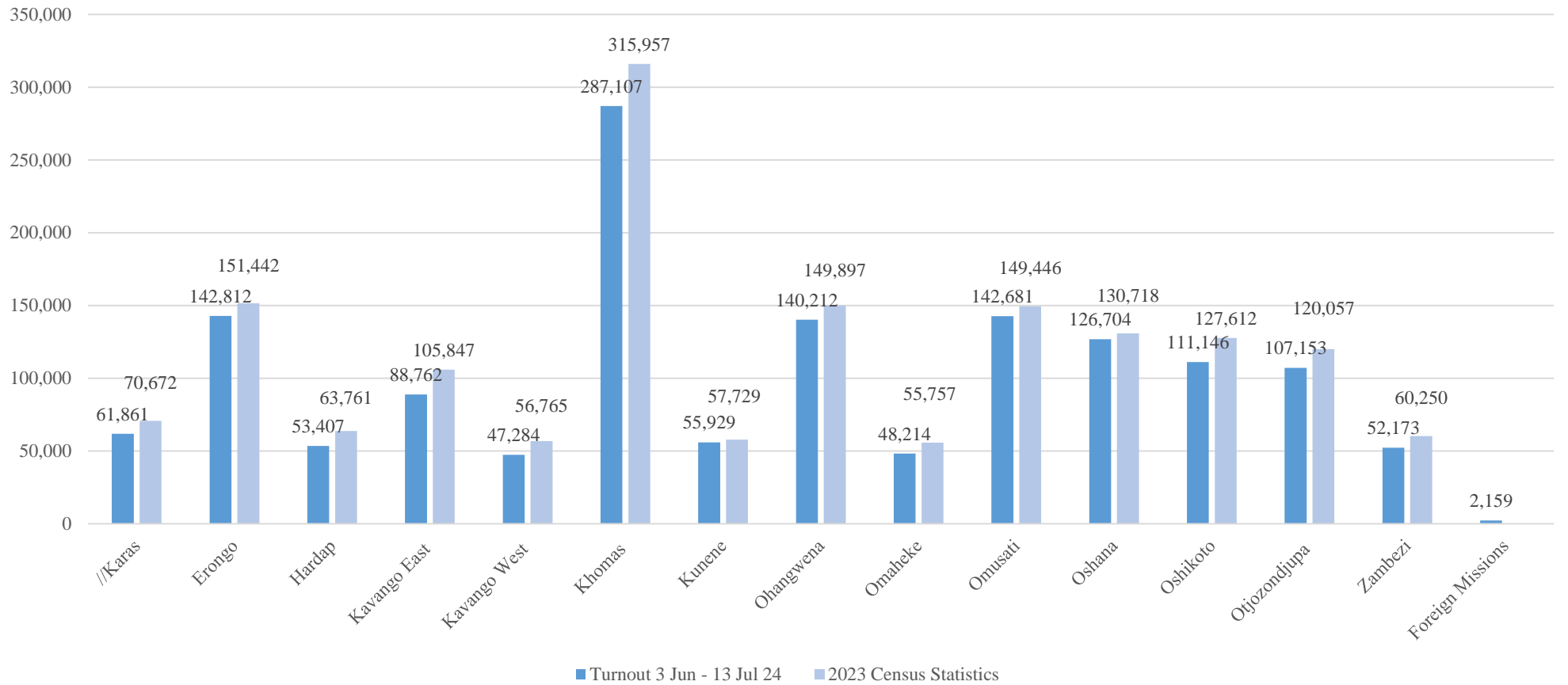


Figure 2: Preliminary Regional Turnout 03 June – 01 August 2024

This brings the overall cumulative number of eligible Namibians registered as voters, both within the country and at Namibian Diplomatic Missions abroad, to **1,467,604** representing a turnout of **91%** of eligible voters for the GRV. The *cumulative number of registered voters* per region is depicted in **Figure 1**. In addition, **Figures 2 and 3** depict an overview of the turnout of registered voters per constituency in all 14 regions for the period of **03 June – 01 August 2024**.

The Commission extends its deepest gratitude to all registered voters and electoral stakeholders who have demonstrated unwavering support towards ensuring effective voter education campaigns since the commencement of the GRV until its conclusion. The collective efforts of our stakeholders in supporting and enhancing the Commission's communication drive and strategy to have eligible voters registered, are invaluable.

As per the 2024 Electoral Calendar, the Commission will now begin demobilizing the registration teams, both locally and internationally, and return all registration materials and equipment to the ECN Head Quarters. This will be followed by uploading of the registration data to the Central Server and the commencement of the Automatic Fingerprint Identification System (AFIS) process, data segregation and the production of the Provisional Voters Register (PVR). The PVR will be published in the Government Gazette on 29 August 2024, and will be available for inspection and objections at designated locations (to be announced at a later stage) within the timelines set in the Electoral Calendar.

**Figure 1: Cumulative Provisional Turnout Per Region 03 June - 01 August 2024**

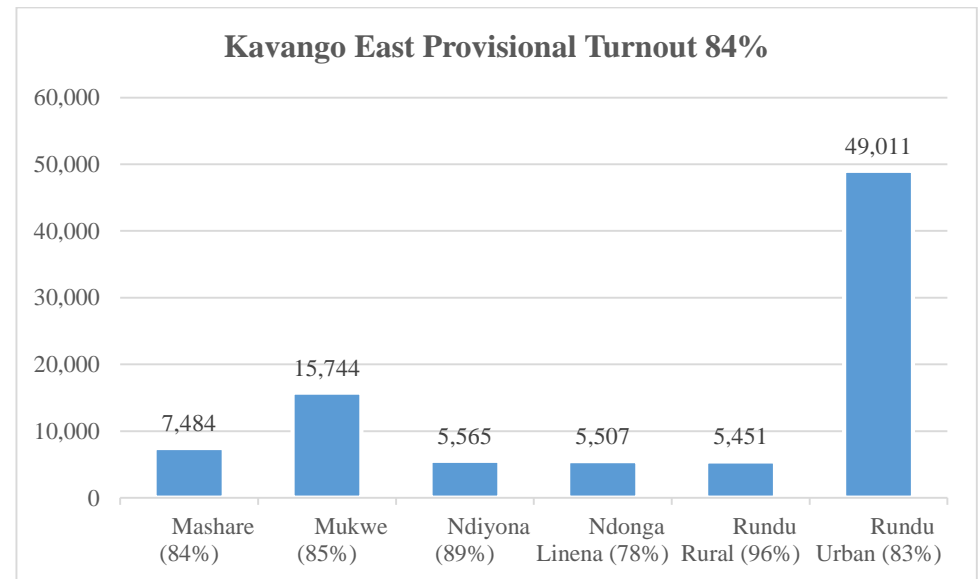
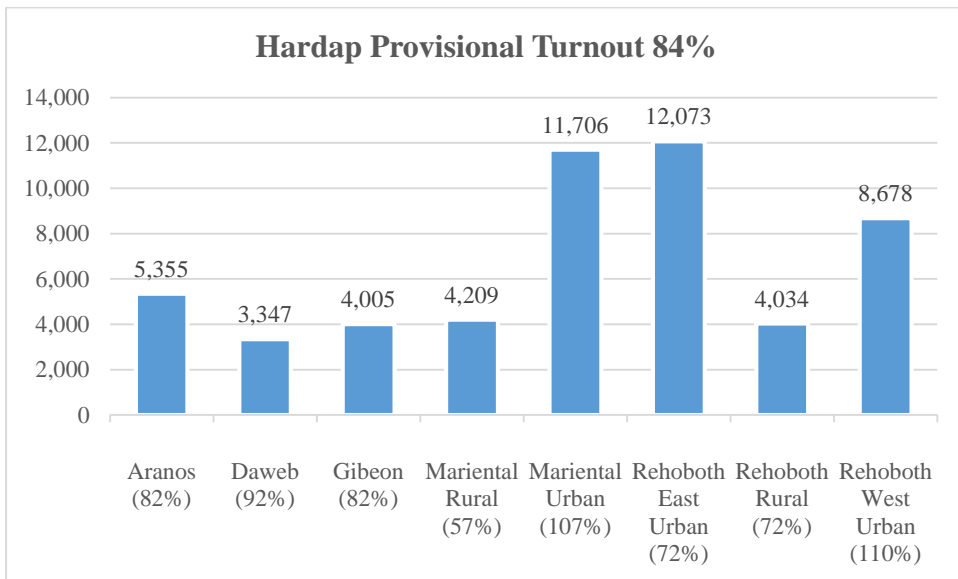
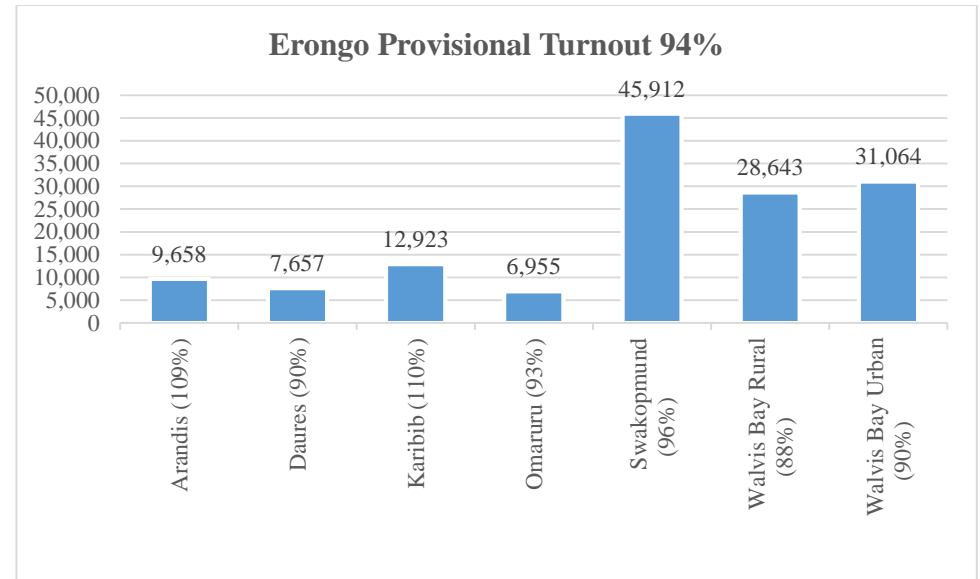
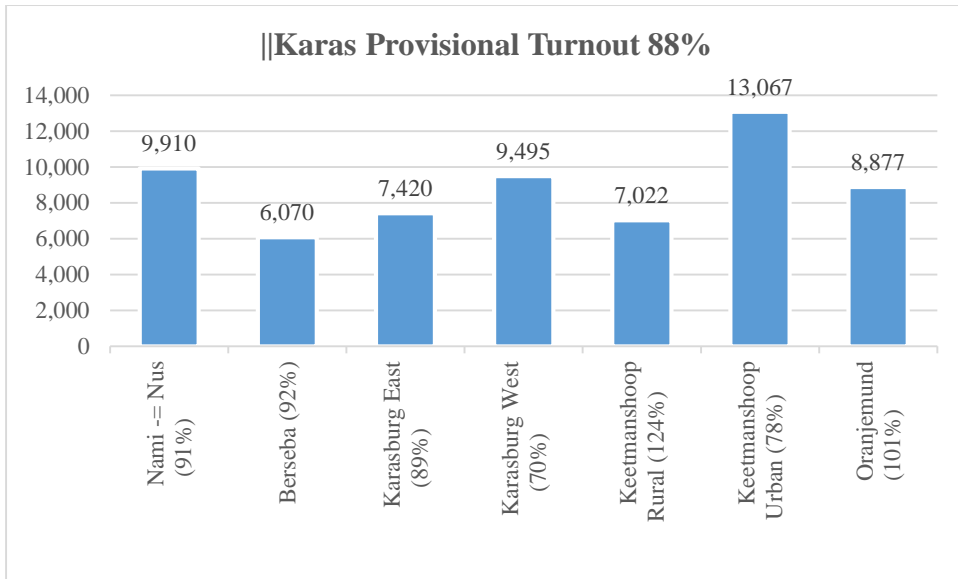


Figure 2: Preliminary Regional Turnout 03 June – 01 August 2024

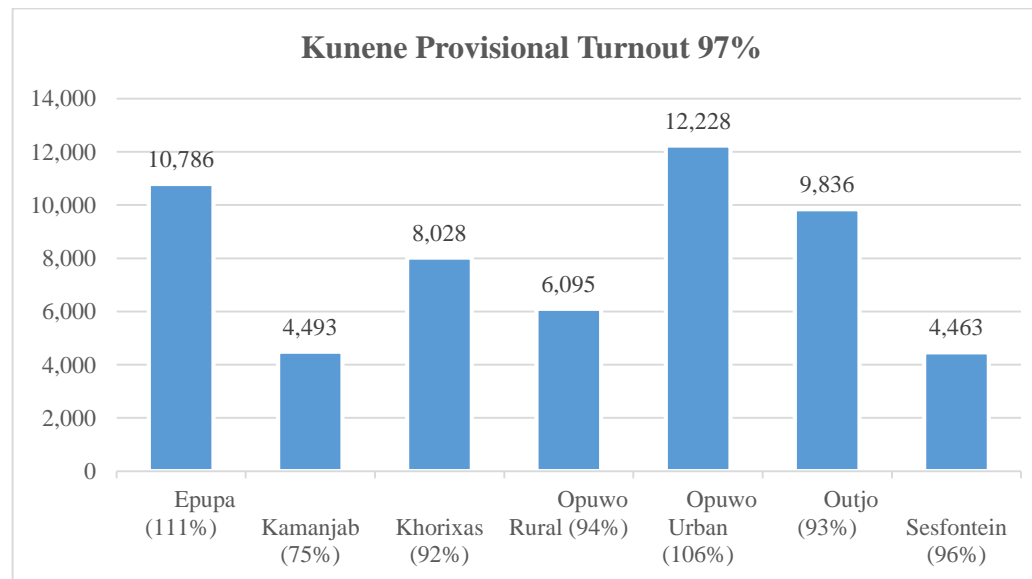
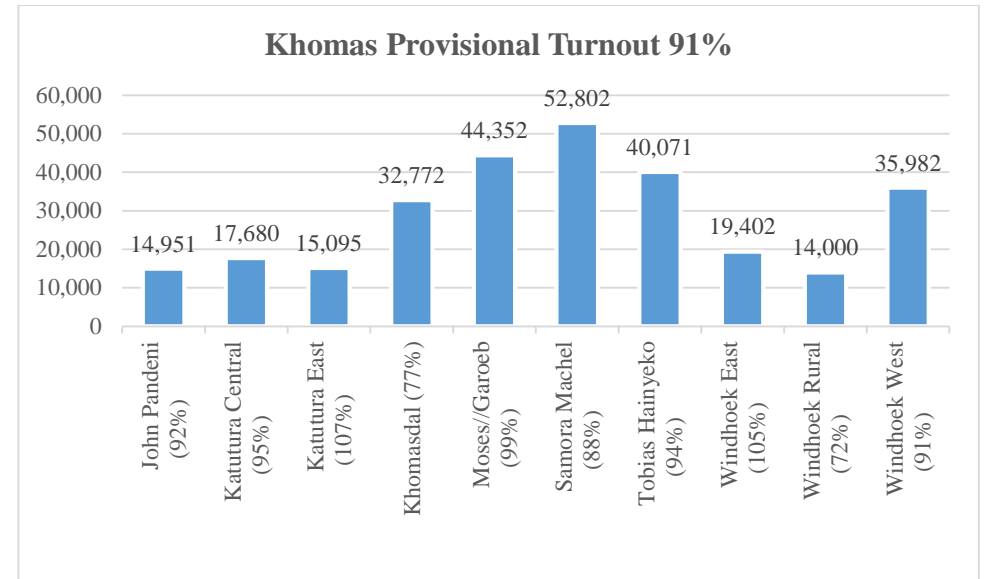
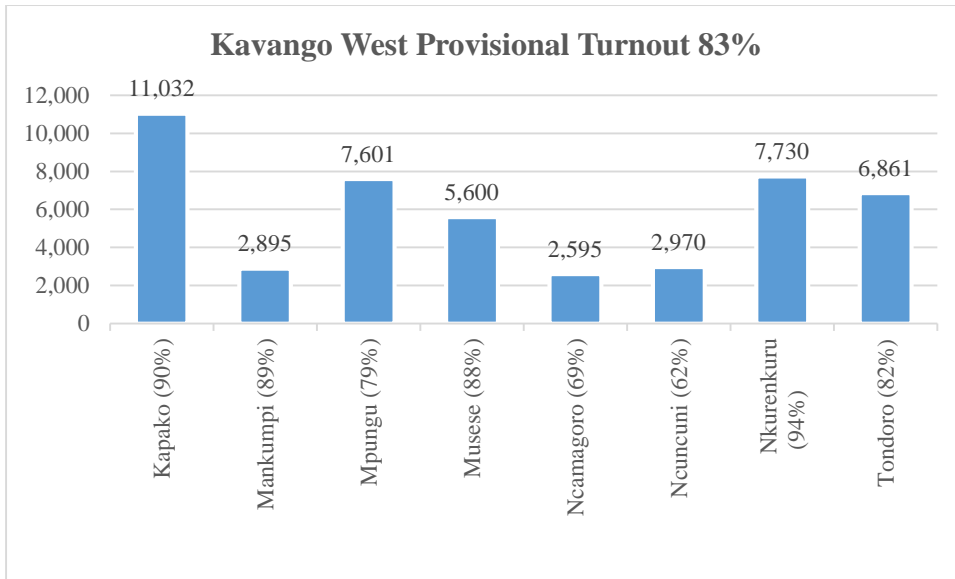


Figure 3: Preliminary Regional Turnout 03 June – 01 August 2024

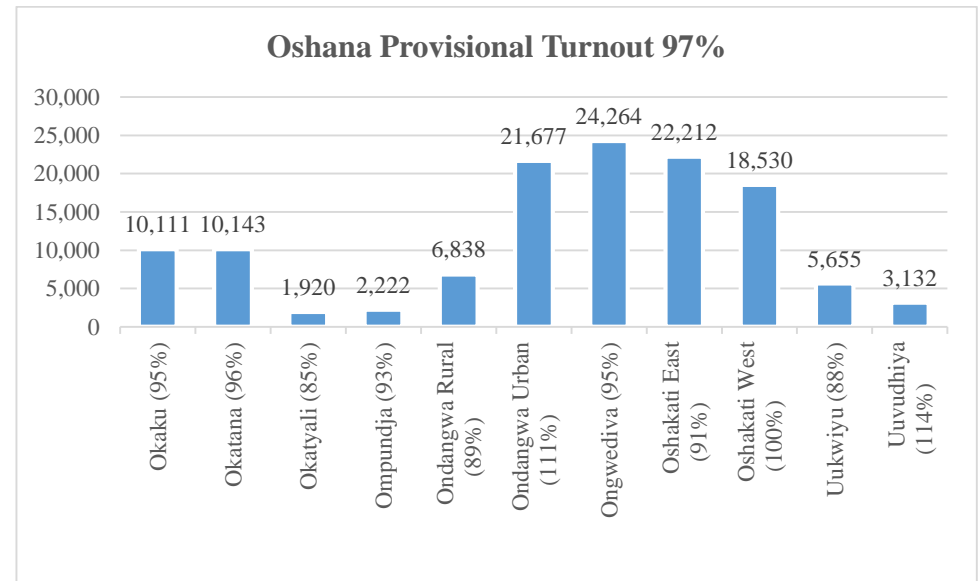
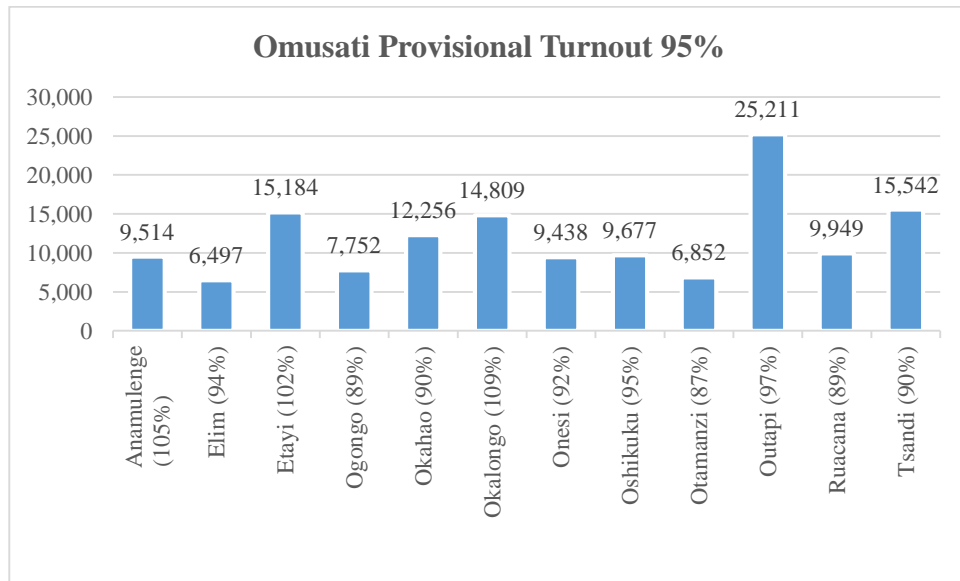
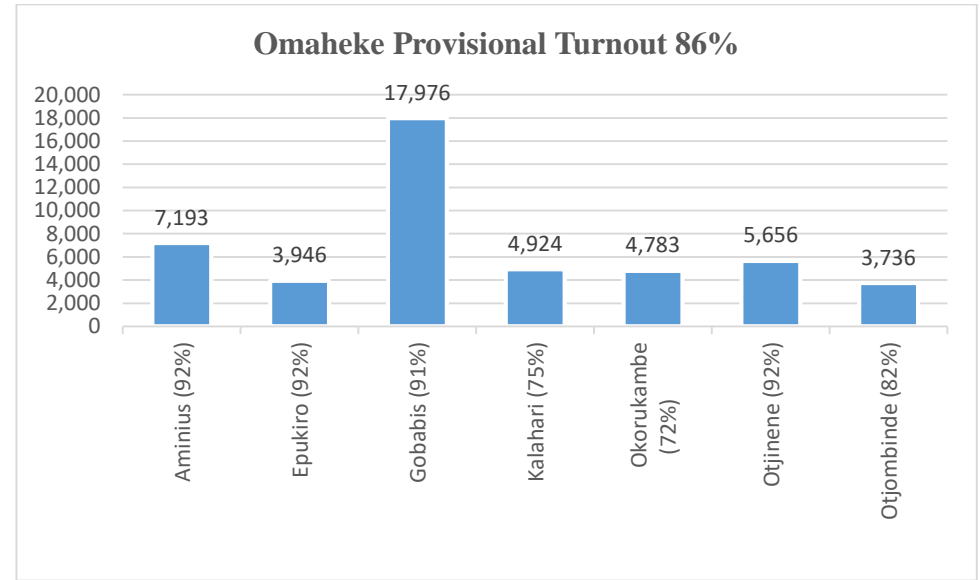
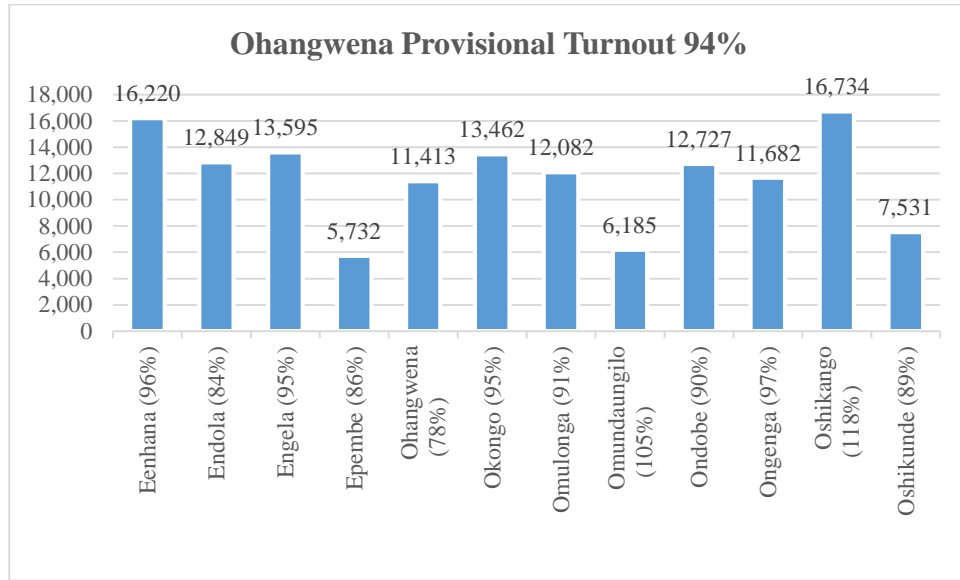


Figure 3: Preliminary Regional Turnout 03 June – 01 August 2024
